

Our week: Owls - We have been learning to tell the story of Jack and the Beanstalk, with actions, which we are going to perform when we have practised it for a little longer. The paintings of beanstalks done by some of our older children and new starters are so creative and the children enjoyed investigating how to make different shades of green. In maths we have been measuring, inside the classroom and outdoors, using different things. We have been finding out about the different parts of a plant and Ryan explained that, "the roots stop it from blowing out of the ground!" Barn owls have had an exciting week as they all did their first piece of work in their new writing books - how very grown up! **Moles -** This week we have launched our dinosaur topic and made an exciting discovery in the outdoor area! We found some dinosaur bones buried outside and excavated them to take a closer look. We have also written some fantastic recounts of what happened. In maths lessons we have been solving missing number problems and we have thought about the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction. **Kingfishers -** Kingfishers have returned to school refreshed and very enthusiastic about their learning. We have been looking at our new text *The Minpins* by Roald Dahl and predicting what they think might happen in the story. In maths, we have had a big focus on fractions and decimals this week, including finding equivalent fractions. **Kestrels -** The Y5 and 6 children have been very busy this week. They have researched the Tour de Yorkshire and are excited about the race. In maths, the Y5s have been busy adding and subtracting using decimals while the Y6s have been revising fractions, angles and perimeter in preparation for SATS.
