




Medium Term Plan

Year 4 – Autumn 1 2021

<p>English</p> <p>In Miss Howes’ class this half term your child will be taught:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To write a non-chronological report. • To write a biography. • To write an explanation text. <p>This will involve:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Identifying the features of the associated texts. ▪ Writing in the style of the associated texts. ▪ Developing their punctuation and self-editing skills. ▪ Reinforcing their knowledge of spelling rules and extending their vocabulary. <p>The children will also develop their reading & comprehension skills using a variety of texts.</p> <p>In Mrs Hudson’s Class this half term, your child will be taught to write an adventure story.</p> <p>They will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write a sequence of sentences, punctuated with a capital letter and a full stop, exclamation mark or question mark. • Use commas to separate items in lists. • Use suffixes –ed, -er • Use age group appropriate conjunctions to expand sentences. • Use prefix Anti- and Auto- • To describe characters and how they may feel in different parts of the story. 	<p>Maths</p> <p>This half term your child will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recap numbers to 1000. • Round numbers to the nearest 1000. • Count in 25s and 1000s. • Order numbers. • Compare 4-digit numbers. • Work with negative numbers. • Use Roman numerals. <p>Alongside this all pupils will be developing their mental arithmetic and Times Tables.</p>	<p>PHSE</p> <p>This half term your child will be taught about the topic, <i>Me and my Relationships</i>.</p> <p>They will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Why rules are important. • How to work as a team. • Conflict resolution. • About positive relationships.
		<p>MFL</p> <p>This half term your child will recap basic Spanish vocabulary including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Numbers to 10. • Greetings. • Classroom instructions. <p>This half term your child will also celebrate the many languages spoken by the children in  our class.</p>

<p>Science</p> <p>This half term Year 4 will be learning about States of Matter. Your child will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ How to compare and group together according to whether they are solids, liquids and gases. ▪ That some materials change state when they are heated or cooled. ▪ To measure temperature using a thermometer. ▪ To identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle. ▪ To associate the rate of evaporation with temperature. <p>Your child will also learn to work scientifically to plan, evaluate and record their scientific work.</p>	<p>RE</p> <p>In RE this half term your child will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What different people believe about God. • Who is a Christian and what they believe. • Who is a Muslim and what they believe. 	
<p>Computing</p> <p>In Computing this half term, your child will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Develop their skills in coding. • Learn how to use a selection of coding commands, flowcharts and algorithms. <p>Some children will develop their skills to test and debug their program designs.</p> 	<p>Music</p> <p>During this half term, Year 4 will be continuing to learn the ukulele. The children will be learning how to follow and play back a piece of music.</p> 	<p>PE (Tuesday and Thursday)</p> <p>In PE this half term, your child will be swimming or learning Yoga and following the unit of work on invasion games.</p> <p>If they are swimming they will consolidate and develop their ability in water with the aim is to be able to swim competently, confidently, and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres.</p>
<p>Art</p> <p>This half term your child will be studying Anglo-Saxon stone sculpture. Your child will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Evaluate a selection of designs. • Sketch some of the Anglo Saxon patterns. • Create prototypes of their own Anglo Saxon inspired designs. • Work with clay to create their final piece of art work. • Develop their self evaluation skills. 	<p>History</p> <p>In history, your child will be studying the invasion of Britain by the Anglo-Saxons and Scots.</p> <p>The children will be taught:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Who the Anglo Saxons were, when they invaded Britain and what life looked like under their rule. • To use chronology to create a timeline to understand where this period of History fits with other British Historical Events. • About the impact of the Anglo Saxons and Scots on today's Britain. 	<p>If they are learning Yoga, they will learning about different types of breathing, balancing and self-awareness.</p> <p>Your child will also be learning invasion games, which involves playing competitive games, developing a wider range of skills including attacking and defending.</p>
